



Special Rules for Georgia Participants

Don't...	Do...
<p>Don't delay in beginning participation in the game.</p>	<p>Do make the first transaction within the first three weeks of the beginning of the game or the team number will be invalidated.</p>
<div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin: 0 auto; width: 80%;"> <p><i>These are the Georgia rules; they will be enforced when selecting the regional and state winners.</i></p> </div>	
<p>Don't allow students to purchase only one stock to hold for the duration of the game.</p>	<p>Do ensure that over the 10 week simulation, students purchase a minimum of 3 different stocks and hold each stock for a minimum of 3 weeks.</p>
<p>As part of special Georgia-specific rules, students must purchase at least 3 stocks that cost at least \$5 per share and buy a minimum of 100 shares, and hold these stocks for a minimum of three weeks.</p> <p><i>After meeting the Georgia rule, students may also purchase stocks that cost as little as \$3 per share and buy as few as 10 shares of that stock.</i></p>	
<p>Each team begins with \$100,000 in cash and may borrow additional funds based upon equity in the account. Interest is charged weekly on negative cash balances at the annual rate of 7%, and credited weekly on positive cash balances at the annual rate of .75%.</p>	
<p>Students may purchase common stocks, preferred stocks, and/or mutual funds listed on the New York Stock Exchange, American Stock Exchange, and NASDAQ Stock Market.</p>	
<p>The margin line of credit is \$50,000.00 meaning students can actually spend \$150,000.00 in their initial purchase.</p>	
<p>All transactions are based on the daily closing price. Teams may trade on any day the markets are open. Trades entered after close of market (4 pm Eastern time) will be priced at the next day's closing price.</p>	
<p>A transaction fee of 1% is charged for all purchases and sales.</p>	
<p>Portfolios are updated daily. Rankings are posted weekly.</p>	
<p>Teams should not liquidate their portfolios at the end of the 10 weeks. Winners will be determined on the basis of equity in the portfolio at the end of the final transaction day.</p>	
<p><i>Send you registration fee or purchase order to GCEE by the end of the 5th week of the Game. Unpaid team fees will result in the cancellation of team numbers and disqualification in the competition.</i></p>
